Submissions Process

- Have read and understand the SGS&C rules
- Have paid application fee in accordance with the SGS&C rules (business or nonprofit organization submissions only)
- Have a plan for a chaperone for team members under 18 on November 26 through November 30, 2018 while representing the game at I/ITSEC. (See Rules for more detail.)
- Completed online Submission Form

Serious game and supporting materials upload

Please refer to the submission form instructions on website for guidance on completing the checklist requirements.

- All files, installation instruction and game play directions necessary to play the game.
- High resolution organization logo (vector format preferred or minimum 300 DPI raster image)
- Signed Declaration of Eligibility and Release of Liability (includes authorization to use logo and game in SGS&C marketing)
- Video-captured demo of gameplay (For movies, MP4, AVI, WMV or QT format.)
- High resolution game screen shots (800x600 or higher)

Qualities of a good screenshot

Game screenshots are used in promotional material and briefings to leadership, so it is important that that they represent your game well. Here are a few guidelines that will help you create good screenshots:

- Capture a representative image of gameplay.
- Make it sufficiently high resolution (800X600 or higher).
- Do not include overlay graphics.
- Do not include marketing material.
- Make it eye-catching.
- The image should be of easily identifiable objects.
- The image should be a clear representation to anyone unfamiliar with the game.
